

Sevenoaks Train Walk

Starting our walk from the train station in the delightful town of Sevenoaks, this walk, of approx. 10 miles, takes a circular route briefly calling at two magnificent National Trust properties: Knole House followed by Ightham Mote.

Our route straddles the Kentish Greensand Way through both open grassland and historic woodland, with views across to the Weald & North Downs. This is a lovely walk in Kent's rolling countryside.

For those of you who wish to visit Knole House and take a shorter walk, there are three National Trust short, signposted trails from the front of the house. At weekends, Knole House is very busy and it will be necessary to book an entry, via the NT website, I would suggest not before 11:30am, allowing time to walk from the Railway Station.

Toilets and café facilities are available at both NT properties.
