Parks and Sculptures by Day and Spectacular Winter Lights Festival by Night



Tuesday 21st January 2025

Walk Starts at either 1pm or 5pm. Meet outside Canary Wharf Station (E14 4HJ), served by the Jubilee (grey) line. Giant escalators take you to the main promenade, as you come out of the station, you will be welcomed by the tall office buildings.

Parks and Sculptures by Day (Starts at 1pm)

3-hour circular walk covering parks and numerous interesting sculptures that Canary Wharf has to offer. We will visit Crossrail Place, Canada Square, Cabot Square, West Ferry Circus, Bank Street, Jubilee, Montgomery, Wood Wharf and the confusing but cool "Traffic Lights Tree" at the entrance to Canary Wharf and Billingsgate Fish Market. There will be many opportunities for toilet stops along the way and there are public conveniences at West Ferry Circus where I intend to have a coffee stop.

Interval 4pm - 5pm Outside Canary Wharf Station (E14 4HJ) served by the Jubilee (grey) line.

For those wanting to do the entire day I have allowed plenty of time to grab a coffee and a bite to eat before the Light festival commences. If anyone would like to just join us for the evening, please make sure you are there for 5pm.

Spectacular Winter Lights Festival by Night (Starts at 5pm)

We will be covering similar ground for the winter lights festival approx. 2-3hrs (Map to follow)

This is Canary Wharf's Ninth edition that will take us on a journey through twelve spectacular temporary installations. Displaying the most innovative light artists across the globe, the 2025 featuring portals, black holes, and mirages.

Bordering between real and surreal, the line-up will take us from a towering stack of bathtubs pulsing with light and sound, through to West Ferry Circus where you can encounter a mesmerising tornado of lights orbiting a pylon, immerse yourself amongst panels of sari fabric and luminous threads on Wren Landing, be dazzled by an iridescent mirage on Montgomery Square, experience a bird in flight and be transported through a portal in Wood Wharf. Finish the tour at the newly opened Eden Dock, where you can marvel at a 20m wide sink hole encircled by light.
